Technical Systems Developed for Classroom Video Library Project Lesli Scott

Survey Research Operations programmers have been working with multiple University of Michigan departments to develop the Measures of Effective Teaching Extension Video Library. An SRO technical team (led by Dave Padot) has been responsible for creating, integrating and testing systems that allow thousands of concurrent users to securely watch classroom videos from their computers and mobile devices. Several University of Michigan departments collaborated to carry out this effort, including: Education and Well Being Program and Survey Research Operations at the Survey Research Center; Inter-University Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR); School of Education; and the University of Michigan Library. The video library helps members of the education community better understand teaching and learning, including researchers, evaluators, school leaders, teachers, higher education programs, state agencies and others. Before accessing videos, users need to register and affirm that they agree with the requirements of membership.
