Key Terms

Revenue – dollars both direct and indirect costs generated by sponsored projects.
Also called sponsored volume.

All years are in terms of Fiscal Year (July 1 – June 30).

Total cost – Direct plus indirect costs.


Direct cost – dollars charged directly (both salary and non-salary) to a sponsored project.

Indirect cost – dollars generated at a negotiated rate multiplied against direct cost to cover infrastructure costs of an organization (facilities, administrative time, etc).

Project Suite – a "family" of related projects. For example, HRS includes, HRS Panel, HRS New Cohort, HCAP and HRS Whole Blood.

What does 2017 look like?

2017 is predicted to be even bigger than 2016 in terms of total volume (Chart D). This is due to continued high volume in current projects (including HRS & PSID) and expansion into the Housing & Children's Healthy Development (HCHD) project. Chart D



Indirect cost rate (Indirect cost/Direct cost) for 2017 represents 38% of direct cost for a continued strong recovery rate for our sponsored portfolio.

Currently, we are working on the 2017 Overhead budget to accompany the portfolio of sponsored projects. Projected hours are very similar to 2016 (Chart E) and are likely to increase to support the volume of interviewer hours and work is leveraged across regular staff roles.
