### FY23 Financial Summary


We completed \$39.9M in total **sponsored** project work, generating \$11.2M in indirect cost recovery fees (IDC).

- -Represents a 20.1% *increase* in IDC volume compared with FY22. SRO generated a high effective IDC rate\* of 39% in 2023, similar to the effective rates SRO has experienced over the last five fiscal years due to an increased proportion of high IDC projects in our portfolio.
- —In FY23 we were very close to our budget expectations for the year. We completed only .6% less (255K) in sponsored work than our "medium" estimate at the start of the fiscal year!
- -We had a \$4.7M operations (overhead) budget allocation and ended the year with an underrun of \$214K (4.5% underrun).




#### A Different View of Volume

- SRO worked on 46 unique projects. Six of those projects had multiple funding mechanisms. Multiple funders are sometimes necessary given the total costs of some projects, but it adds a lot of complexity to cost monitoring.
- We processed 6,809 interviewer expense reports (vs. 2,348 in FY22) and 1,081 travel advances (618 in FY22).
- We processed \$629,698 in respondent payments (\$249,115 in FY22).
- We reimbursed \$800,252 for mileage, which is 1,212,504 miles (\$239,360 in FY22)
- A total of 373 new interviewers were hired in FY23. The split by category was 314 in the field and 59 in the SSL. In 2022 we hired 99 in the field and 63 in the SSL.

### Survey Design Consultations

- In FY23, SRO provided consultation in sampling design, questionnaire design, or data collection best practices to 74 research initiatives outside of SRO
  - 56 for U-M departments or Michigan Medicine
  - 12 for external colleges and universities
  - 6 for various foundations, institutes, private companies








### Fiscal Year 2024 Financial Summary




### FY24 compared to FY23









### FY24 Sponsored Projections compared to FY24 Budget



## SRO Reg Staff over time




## SRO Interviewing Staff over time

# **Highlighted Upcoming Projects**

### American National Election Study (ANES)

- University of Michigan and Stanford University, funded by the National Science Foundation
- First pilot data collection in 1948
- Provide data to inform understanding of election outcomes
- Data collection conducted in two waves between August 2024 and early 2025, a Pre-election wave and a Post-election wave
- 2023 methodological work



### American National Election Survey (ANES)

- Face-to-face interviews, web surveys, live video interviews, and paper questionnaires
- Panel sample and a new probability sample
  - 1200 FTF completes (55% response rate)
  - 2400 web completes (40% response rate)
  - 2375 panel completes (89% response rate)
  - 85%-90% response rates expected on the Post-election survey
- Dates are not flexible!
  - March 2023 Sampling
  - March 2024 Pre-production
  - August 2024 Pre-election data collection → ELECTION DAY: November 5, 2024
  - November 2024 Post-election data collection

### National Dementia Workforce Study (NDWS)

- Interdisciplinary initiative led by teams at the University of Michigan Michigan Medicine and the Survey Research Center - and the University of California, San Francisco
- National Institute on Aging (NIA)
- Meeting the care needs of the nation's growing population of persons living with dementia
  - In 2020, over 6 million Americans had Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia (ADRD)
- Develop and field four new annual national surveys of the dementia care workforce, including physicians, nurses, and direct care workers across multiple care settings.

#### National Dementia Workforce Study (NDWS)

#### SRC/SRO will provide:

- RFP management and selection of data collection organizations
- Sample frame development, sample design and implementation, weighting and non-response adjustment
- Rostering protocol development and respondent selection
- Questionnaire development and testing
- Methodological direction
- Comprehensive survey management
- Data preparation and management
