


Fiscal Year 2024 Financial Summary






Fiscal Year 2025 Financial Outlook






SRO Revenues and Reg Staff over time






SRO Regular Staff by Department

- Pre-election IWer training early July
 - ~40 on-staffers + ~30 new hires
- Post-election IWer training November 4

Applicant Tracking System



- "A powerful and modern Applicant Tracking System" that streamlines and optimizes interviewer recruitment (especially mobile applications)
- All-in-one recruitment software out of Stockholm, Sweden
- Starting using it in Data Collection Operations about a year ago; the first project was CDS 2023 in August 2023
- So far....8,752 total candidates (including our on-staffers)
- Hired for 50 projects 8 new hire projects, 42 on-staffer projects (includes field and SSL)

So far...

- While we continue to work on improvements, candidates report that it is fast and very user-friendly
- The messaging interface has been an excellent way to contact candidates during recruitment, job offer, and onboarding process
- Candidates can indicate interest in our positions even if we do not have any open, which allows our recruiters to review and assess our candidate pool and begin recruitment and hiring prior to the placement of any job ads
- These features have resulted in time savings and better use of our recruitment dollars



New SRC Director: Pam Davis-Kean

- Appointment starts September 1
- Strong ties to U-M through LSA and OVPR
- Not a deep history with leading primary data collection, or collaboration with SRO
- Meeting in July to start planning relationship/structure


