WalSS Project (Jeffrey Albrecht)

The U-M Wallenberg Institute Student Survey (WalSS, pronounced "ways") project is a 5-year longitudinal study of how undergraduate students' perceptions of religious and racial/ethnic groups develop during their time studying at U-M. WalSS is internally funded by <u>U-M's Wallenberg Institute</u>. The PI is Mark Tessler, who is the Samuel J. Eldersveld Collegiate Professor in Political Studies

The WalSS pre-study launched in February 2025 and concludes at the end of April. The purpose is to design and develop a survey that will measure constructs such as religious beliefs, upbringing, and affiliations, as well as prejudice and ingroup/outgroup preferences. Pre-study work entails literature review, survey design consultation with SRC faculty, survey spec'ing and programming in Qualtrics, and testing in focus groups with undergrads. For the prestudy, WalSS paid \$50 Tango cards to focus group participants.

The main survey launches in September 2025 and will repeat each fall through 2029, following students who are still enrolled. The Year 1 sample will include 14,500 U-M students at all undergraduate class levels. In Years 2-5, the sample will be refreshed with new first year students. The protocol will include emails, text messages, and SSL reminder calling. WalSS will use Web SMS for its sample management system, linked with Qualtrics API. Respondents will be offered \$20 Tango cards through the Qualtrics-Tango API for instant payment upon survey completion. The survey length target is 100-125 questions for an average of 15 minutes to complete. SRO will construct survey weights and conduct analysis of the data following each wave of data collection.

The Commuter Challenge encourages community members who live or work in the City of Ann Arbor, City of Ypsilanti, or Ypsilanti Township to choose sustainable transportation (such as walking, biking, carpooling, vanpooling, and using public transit) for travel to and from work. Sign up is available now and the challenge runs May 1 through May 31, 2025.

You can get an early start on the prizes by recording green commutes from April 22 - May 3 to be entered into a drawing for a Spin gift card. Record at least one green commute May 1 - 31 to receive a coupon for a free scoop of ice cream from Washtenaw Dairy.
